Moraiy VeRabosaiy:

The person who has been selling us arba minim at the Shul for a few years now will be servicing us this year again.

If you prefer to shop around and wait in a long line for a posek, you can do that. You are NOT being pressured to buy, chas veshalom. This is purely for your benefit. Nobody is profiting from this (but the socher).

ESROGIM

The esrogim have been carefully and slowly picked and checked out first. They will be sold in a closed box, each marked with a different level.

After you take the level you ordered, you can open the box and show it to me. I, alone, have the right to disqualify its level, on the night of the sale only. Last year, I think it happened once, maybe twice.

LULAVIM

The lulavim, as last year, are coming in a patented sealed lulav-in-a-bag (Eida Charedis), to guarantee freshness. The guarantee is valid if it is unopened until at least the Tuesday before Sukkos.

You will be able to see the lulav completely, except maybe for the closed top. For the lulav tops, you are trusting the moreh hora'ah. (For the the alef/alef and alef levels, this is the Eidah Hachareidis).

The lulav will be of the highest quality for that sug (this applies to all the sugim), picked and chosen carefully by a moreh hora'ah much more machmir than you would ever be.

I will be in RBS on Tuesday before Sukkos, and if you want to open it and look, and feel it is not up to the standards you were expecting, you may come to me. If I agree, it will be switched (in Yerushalayim).

Or, you can open it on the spot by the sale, but you'll lose the freshness guarantee; they are no worse than the lulavim you buy regularly, though, so if you have never had a freshness problem, you shouldn't have one now, either.

You will be able to choose from a set of the following levels (includes Lulay, Esrog, and Haddassim):

- * Alef/Alef -- 395 shekel
- * Alef -- 290 shekel
- * Bais 190 shekel
- Kasher lechatchilah (aka Gimmel) -- 125 shekel

The sale will take place the Sunday after Yom Kippur, IYH, between the 2 maarivs (8:15 pm to 10:15 pm). Because of the way we do this, there is no need to come early, to be nervous, push, shove, etc.
