Just 1 Minute a Day!

Maybe you've heard of the 1-Minute Manager, or various other 1-Minute plans.

BTYA has its own version...the **1-Minute Mussar Exercise** (or, you can call it 90/60/90)!

Once a week, we'll send a short mussar piece, concluding with an exercise. Reading the piece will take about 90 seconds.

The exercise is meant to be done every day for a week, requiring just 60 seconds a day (NOT on the Rav's watch...).

At the end of the week, you'll get a question to answer (to yourself, about 90 seconds of time) to concretize the lesson of the week (and 'force' you to do the exercises daily) before moving on to the next week's avoda.

This program has been proven—besides being a weeklong exercise to inculcate a particular mussar concept—to be able to change a person completely: to be a baal aliya, someone open to change in general, someone sensitive to avodas atzmi, someone sensitive to good middos and the need to cultivate the good and prune the bad, etc.

The mussar piece will be 2 - 3 paragraphs from selected mussar seforim, with a preference for seforim that already have an English translation.

In the concluding 90-second exercise, you will answer - What areas of change did you take on this past week in your 1-minute mussar avoda?

This pilot program will continue through עשרת ימי אי"ה, תשובה.

We acknowledge Rav Dolinky Shlita's very similar concept practiced in his Sunday "va'adim." We urge whoever can, to join the va'adim, as attending them has various advantages over this program.

Excerpt from the coming week's exercise:

Rav Chaim Friedlander in Sifsei Chaim writes, "The yemei ratzon of Ellul are days that HaShem draws close to us, and helps us to draw closer to Him, moreso than other times of the year. However, this does not happen only from Hashem's side; rather, the effort toward hiskarvus must be mutual and shared between both sides."

...As we enter Elul and approach the Yom HaDin, we too recognize that the few blasts of the shofar is not sufficient for the daunting task that is upon us.

...I ask you, Rabosai, for one minute each day this coming week....Break the shackles of behavior patterns, and allow yourself to take a step toward Hashem, so He will take His towards us!
