**Torah Programming:****Good News – Bad News, and a Special Offer**

B"H, Torah learning in the shul has been thriving in our Bais Medrash from early in the morning through the afternoon, and late into the evening. So, it is with a heavy heart that the focus of the recent meeting regarding Torah in the shul was how and where to cut back in order to get our expenditures in line with our expected donations.

This past year, the month-to-month survival was most definitely b'gader supernatural, and mostly fell upon the shoulders of a few ba'alei batim connected to the shul. So, in order to relieve the month-to-month pressure and so as not to be "somech al hanes," we have decided that we have no choice but to begin cutting back, starting in Elul.

If we had 10 people step up and commit to \$100 per month there would be no need to cut back anything in the current budget (this could be either new people or adding to one's present commitment). And more would enable us to expand and fulfill many plans that we have.

On a personal note, I can tell you that that is rare to find a "ma'aser" opportunity that you can see having such an effect right in front of your own eyes. There is a sense of the geshmak of learning that spreads from ba'alei batim to avreichim and vice versa – inspiring everyone.

Loosely translated – Torah is a Tree of Life that enriches those that support it. In this situation I can assure you that even if it does not enrich your bottom line, it will surely give those that support it much satisfaction in this world and the next.

If someone would like an even bigger incentive to support Torah in our shul, the Rav is making a special offer to the first 15 people who step forward. The Rav has offered to learn personally with those that take this challenge, once a week, for half an hour\*, on any subject they desire

## YBHZ

Moraiy VeRabosaiy:

We have the following problem: As you probably know, for about 2 years now, the Shul has been one of the "mokdim" of the RBSA Yeshivas Bein Hazemanim.

The Shul was abuzz with kids (and adults) learning; it was a sea-change from what was in the past. It encouraged learning in the Shul far beyond those particular hours.. that is how these things work.

And while you perhaps feel that there is no direct benefit to the Shul in being one of the hosts of YBHZ, I respectfully disagree, and feel that it cemented our Shul as a major player in being a mokom Torah in RBSA. This is not measurable or provable - but it is poshut to me that being "put on the map" in that way brought and brings people in to learn in our Shul all hours of the day, all days of the year.

It also gives our teen-age kids great pride in "their" Shul.

I never looked too carefully at the finances of YBHZ too carefully or closely. Until now.

With the help of Yirmi (thank you!) who sat with the heads of YBHZ and went over facts and figures, what emerges is that we must cover ONLY 12.5% of the total budget. The reason this is so, that we do not have to contribute a full 33% (there are 3 mokdim now - Mas'as Mordechai, us, and the Gra) is not relevant right now.

However, this 12.5 % comes out to 10-12,000 shekel. (Once again, Yirmi went over the figures with them)

(And I owe 20--22,000 shekel for the last two bein hazemanims.)

Now, this is not something I'd dream of taking from the Torah Programming budget - not the way it stands now nor in the foreseeable future.

I am not a fundraiser that has a pool of donors I can go to.

I have a few days to find a person or people whom this may "speak to," that is, hundreds of kids learning a few hours a day bein hazemanim, and the great benefits to the Shul. Sometimes, someone is touched by a particular inyan, and he or she steps up.

If I don't find 10-12,000 shekel by Sunday or Monday, we are NOT part of this enterprise. (I am trying not to think about the old chov.)

Maybe, maybe, maybe there is someone out there that this 'speaks to'.....You? Or someone you know?

## Rav's Shiurim

The Rav is suspending, hopefully temporarily, his **חובות הלכות** nightly shiur for men, his **קיצור שולחן ערוך** shiur, and the **תניא** shiur (which has been suspended for a while now), and the **פרקי אבות** shiur in **החיים** דרך.

In the cases of the first three, it awaits a commitment from, say, 6 people for nightly attendance (in the case of the **תניא** shiur, weekly attendance).

Regarding the **פרקי אבות** shiur, it is very, very sad that it is apparently so difficult for so many people who are really supposed to be devoting the bulk of Shabbos to learning Torah (**מראי מקומות** available upon request) to stay and learn something for 30-45 minutes between a 6 PM minchah Shabbos afternoon and 30 full minutes before sheki'ah. So sad.

Any suggestions for a different magid shiur (no kidding) or a different subject matter, or both, which would draw people to use this short period of time the way Chazal envisioned Shabbos being used, would be appreciated.
