**The Rav's View on Airline Ethics**

I received answers from quite a few people. All well-intended, no doubt. Perhaps one day I will analyze with you the answers given.

Once El Al decided to honor the tickets, there is no question that it is halachically permissible to use them.



But if the reason they are honoring the tickets is because of the negative p.r. that would be generated if they would not, I think a truly ethical person

(on an admittedly high madreiga, something akin to Rav Safra in BB 88A) should not use it. Why not?

Because you are taking advantage of an error in labeling the price, and getting the ticket for less than they ever intended to sell it for. All the cheshbonos being bandied about now cannot wash away that truth.

But most people do not live by that standard - it is a real midas chasidus.

If they are legally bound to honor them, then I think it is ok. Reason? There is a reason why that is the law (too involved to get into now). I would call it a takanas hashuk. I do not think one need be more ethical than a takanas hashuk. It might even be detrimental to the society for whom the takana was made.

UNLESS at the time the person bought it, he/she knew that he/she was taking advantage of some sort of crazy error.

If that is the case, then in any event, I feel that ethics require that it not be used.
