Erev Rosh Hashana Selichos and Shacharis=

Selichos on Erev Rosh Hashana will begin at, for the three minyanim respectively, 5:18, 6:00, and 7:00. There will also be a minyan for selichos at 12:35 AM.

Shacharis will begin at: 6:18, 7:00 and 8:00.

■Rosh Hashana Children's Groups

Thanks to the great response from the girls of our community, we will be having Rosh Hashana groups for children: **Boys**: Ages 2 - 7 and **Girls**: Ages 2 - 9

The groups will take place both days of Rosh Hashana, in Ulam Shabsai from 9 AM – 1 PM.

Important Notes:

- In order for a child to attend the groups, a parent (not a sibling, friend, aunt, etc.) must be present in the building at all times. If a parent is requested to come to the groups, he/she must do so immediately.
- It is a good idea to go downstairs every so often to check on your child, and if you have a rambunctious, leibedig child that likes to wander outside, etc., it would be a good idea to stay with your child.
- All children that are not toilet trained must be accompanied at groups by a parent or sibling that can change them.
- Light snacks and drinks will be available. Please tell the group leaders about any allergies
- If you send your child with a game or toy, please label it and take responsibility for it (if you want it back).
 Please No Balls!
- Group leaders will not, under any circumstances, give any children medicine. If there is such a need, a parent must handle the situation.
- Please do not bring children who are under the weather and contagious to groups.
- A final word: the groups are a chessed offered by the shul (and the volunteers) and is not "included" in payment for a seat. Therefore, if a child misbehaves too much (at the discretion of the group leaders) a parent may be asked to take the child out of the groups.
- Please be advised that neither the shul nor any of the volunteers takes responsibility for the safety and welfare of the children (as well as any toys). They will certainly do their best to watch the children, but there likely will be a lot of children, so parents who leave their children do so at their own risk.

Moraiy VeRabosaiy:

I have arranged for the person who has been selling us arba minim (3 of the 4---no aravos) at the Shul to come and service us this year as well.

While I understand that the way we sell the 4 Minim is "uncustomary," I have found that it is easier, quicker, and gives you really, really nice sechorah, at a decent price, at your doorstep. And there's a track record of many years of very satisfied customers.

If you prefer to shop around, and then to wait in a line for a posek, you can do that, too. You are NOT being pressured to buy, chas veshalom. This is purely for your benefit. Nobody is profiting from this (but the socher).

ESROGIM

The esrogim have been carefully and slowly picked out and checked out first. They will be sold in a closed box, each marked with a different level.

After you take the level you ordered, you can, if you wish, open the box and show it to me. I, alone, have the right to disqualify its level, on the night of the sale only. Last year, I think it happened once.

LULAVIM

The Iulavim are coming in a patented, sealed Iulav-in-abag (Eida Charedis), to guarantee freshness. The guarantee is valid if it is unopened until at least Motzei Shabbos before Sukkos.

You will be able to see the lulav, except maybe for the closed top, completely. For the lulav tops, you are trusting the moreh hora'ah (for the alef/alef, alef, and beis levels, this is the Eidah Hachareidis).

The lulav will be of the highest quality for that sug (this applies to all the sugim), picked and chosen carefully by a moreh hora'ah much more machmir than you would ever be.

If you want to open the lulav bag and look, and then you feel it is not up to the standards you were expecting, you may come to me. If I agree, it will be switched. If you do that after the night of the sale, it will have to be in Yerushalayim.

If you do so before Motzei Shabbos, you'll lose the freshness guarantee; however, they are no worse than the lulavim you buy in the regular way, so if you have never had a freshness problem, you shouldn't have one now, either.


Who Will be Written in the Book?
