- **Check - Shekel or US Dollar** (post-dated checks)
- **Cash** - Shekel or US Dollar (full payment only)

If you plan to pay by Hora'at Keva, PLEASE BRING AN ISRAELI CHECK WITH YOU. WE NEED INFORMATION from the check to be able to fill out the form.

Payment must be made at the time of sign-up in order to reserve your seats.

New Women's Shiur

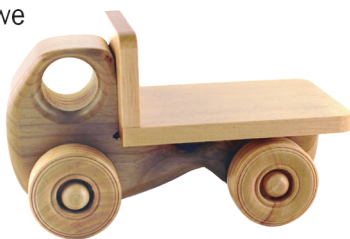
