After you take the level you ordered, you can , if you wish, open the box and show it the Rav, The Rav is the only one who has the right to disqualify its level, on the night of the sale only.

LULAVIM:

The lulavim, as last year, are coming in a patented sealed lulav-in-a-bag (Eida Charedis), to guarantee freshness. The guarantee is valid if it is unopened until at least the Tuesday before Sukkos.

You will be able to see the lulav completely, except maybe for the closed top. For the lulav tops, you are trusting the moreh hora'ah. (For the alef/alef and alef levels, this is the *Eidah Hachareidis*).

The lulav will be of the highest quality for that sug (this applies to all the sugim), picked and chosen carefully by a moreh hora'ah much more machmir than you would ever be.

Ask the Rav about what to do if you are not happy with what you got.

Each set includes an Esrog, a Lulav, and Hadassim

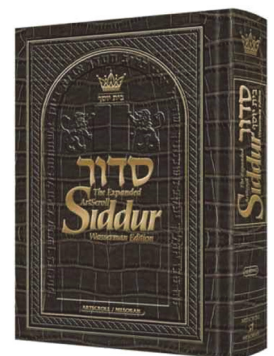
