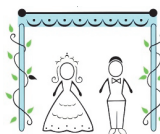

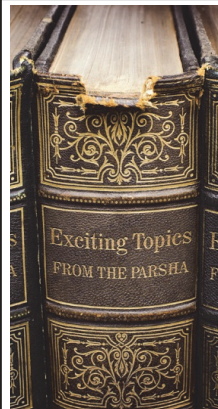

Fridays, at 11am to 12pm, in the BTYA Beis Medrash.

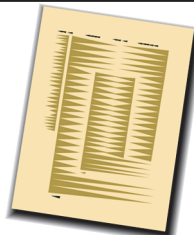
The Halacha Topics shiur follows Rabbi Learman's earlier ongoing Friday shiur :
