Mokom haMikdash

In fulfillment of our obligation to "seek out Tzion", i.e., to actualize our yearning for the rebuilt Beis HaMikdash, BTYA and its guests (70 plus strong) were treated to a shiur about the **Mokom haMikdash** by *avreichim* Yosef Sholom Rabin and Pinchus Abaramowitz, who belong to the larger umbrella group *Tel Talpiyot*, a group of Kollelim devoted to *limud kodoshim*.

The more-than-an-hour shiur slide presentation had three parts: An appreciation of the powerful spiritual properties of the *mokom HaMikdash* throughout all generations, including pre-and post-Beis HaMikdash; The basic halachos of which *temei'im* (ritually impure people) can and cannot go exactly where in the Mikdash compound, and included Har HaBayis and Yerushalayim itself; and how to match up today's reality with the reality we are taught in *Masechess Middos*, where the *Beis HaMikdash* exactly was, the *azarah*, the *ehvehn shesiyah*, and then mapping out the rest. The very knowledgeable *avreichim* presented quite compelling evidence that the Dome of the Rock and the jutting-out rock therein is indeed what the established *mesorah* has long maintained it is-the *ehvehn shesiyah*. This allows those who go up to Har Habayis to know where they can and cannot go. We will iyH be sending out an audio and video link of the shiur.

Stay tuned for "Part Two" which will IY"H take place after Tisha B'Av—a more thorough scholarly discussion of other opinions where everything was located and their proofs; and refutation of their proofs.
