An Important Message from the Rav about Catering



It has come to my attention that some members, or users of the Ulam in general, may be unaware (or may be acting as if unaware) of a firm shul rule: No one may use any caterer in the Ulam unless that caterer has a **hechsher**.

A **hechsher** may consist of a letter from a Rav knowledgeable about *kashrus* (that will be determined by Rav Malinowitz) that he is *achara'ee* (responsible) for the *kashrus* of said caterer. A letter only attesting to the *yir'as shamayim* of the caterer is NOT sufficient.

If the Kanners or Weissmandels are not used, **prior approval must be obtained**. I will also then determine if satisfactory arrangements have been made for any food transportation to the Ulam.

If no caterer is being used (i.e, if the food is being supplied by the *ba'al simchah* and friends and neighbors) I am *meanwhile* continuing to assume that the approved *hechsherim* list in the members guide is being adhered to for food items and ingredients. If that turns out not to be the case, this policy will be reassessed.




