

## A NOTE FROM THE RAV on PUBLIC SUKKAS:

When on a trip during Sukkos, the Rav recommends bringing food which does not ordinarily demand a Sukkah...He hopes that this is an unnecessary precaution, but public Sukkas are notoriously unreliable. Also, the Mishna Berura cites a *chumrah* that a regular meal, just without bread or *mezuzos*, might require a Sukkah (though no *beracha* should be said).
