Simchas Beis HaShoeva



Our beis medrash is our pride and so many of us are growing by leaps and bounds in our skills and in our yedios of Torah. Every year new ideas for learning are put into place and all of RBS benefits from our efforts. I would like to recognize the great new addition of the 9pm Daf Yomi led by R' Simon Baum who filled a gap in our programming that we weren't even aware of. The Mishna continues with "say little and do much". Here I have to give pause. As president, I am privy to see who the anonymous donors are, and I see the tremendous efforts that certain individuals who shall remain nameless- because they insist on remaining nameless- put into the shul. BTYA is the home of saying little and doing much.

But there was one more area that we needed to work on: greeting people with a cheerful face and making everyone feel at home. The author of this Mishna is the Tanna Shammai who was known as a *kapdan*. How ironic that as much as he was a *kapdan* for the honor of the Torah, it was not a contradiction with having a pleasant demeanor.

Avos D'Rabbi Nasan is teaching that you can give a lot to someone but if you don't give cheerfully it's like you gave him nothing at all! It's all about how you give. We already excel in Torah learning, we perform *chasadim* on the highest levels but there was one great hole in our *avodah*- being cheerful- יפות פנים. It's at least a *hidur* mitzvah on all the good that we already do.

This *inyan* was very important to the board and we really worked on improving the atmosphere in the shul. We have made progress in this area over the last year, I feel it and I hope you do as well. There is clearly more simcha and warmth in the shul. I felt it most when wishing everyone a "shana tova..." on the first night of Rosh Hashana. Everyone was so warm, the brochos were said with such intent and good will. I would like to thank the Rav Shlita and Rav Jacobson for putting together the vaad on Wednesday nights that is personally helping me and many others become more aware of their actions. The most recent vaad actually directly dealt with סבר פנים יפות in our relationships within our family. This message applies no less to the kehilla as well.

On behalf of myself and the board I request *mechila* if I or we upset you, or were unfair in any way. And if I didn't greet you יפות פנים, I assure you I will try harder this year. Please be in touch with any ideas on how to continue to improve BTYA.
