#### Fall Back

Israel returns to Standard Time on *Motza'ei* Shabbos at 2:00AM. Remember to set your clocks back one hour before going to sleep!

Davening times at BTYA will generally remain unchanged, except for the obvious:

- $\begin{array}{c} 11 \\ 10 \\ 9 \\ 8 \\ 7 \\ 6 \\ 5 \\ \end{array}$
- Vasikin still starts 25 minutes before sunrise, but your clock will now read an hour earlier.
- **Tefillas Mincha Ketanah** will start at 4:35pm this week. On Sunday and Monday, Mincha will be located in the main **Beis Medrash**. On Tuesday, it will move upstairs to the **Vasikin Room**, and remain there all winter.
- Shabbos start and end times next week will all be an hour earlier.
- Shabbos Shacharis next week (Parshas Noach) will be **5 minutes earlier** at 7:50am.
