1. Kabbalas Shabbos this Shabbos will be what has come to be known as "nussach Carlebach."
2. The world-famous, unforgettable, pre-Purim, but not Purim-dik (well, not TOO MUCH Purim-dik) Oneg-At-Beryl's Once-A-Year-Extavaganza! That's Beryl (and Nava) Thomas, at Nachal Raziel 4/6, for those of you who have just joined us from the Moon. Special accommodations for the humor-impaired.
 This week, more so than any other Oneg, this is a great opportunity to ask the Rav the most burning of your 'burning' questions. Open for men (and women, space permitting), starting from 9:00 PM.
3. There will be an **additional reading of Parshas Zachor** for women, after the completion of davening and not before 10:40.
4. There will be no SEUDAH SH'LISHIS in the Shul with the Rav this Shabbos.
5. Remember to say **boruch hamavdil bein kodesh l'chol**, after 6:34 PM (40 minutes after shki'ah), before doing any melachah or even hachanah on Motzei Shabbos. It is forbidden to prepare on Shabbos for a weekday, and thus, whatever items you may want in Shul for Motzei Shabbos have to be brought either on Friday, or after you say "baruch hamavdil bein kodesh l'chol."
6. A **public havdala** will be said at the beginning of each of the 2 Megillah readings on Motzei Shabbos. Remember to bring your own בשמים.

On Thursday, over 50 people went on a BTYA-organized ניחום אבלים visit to visit the parents of Udi Fogel, the father who was murdered in Itamar last Friday night. What follows is a summary by one of the attendees.

At first it was a bit awkward. All of us standing around in their living room with nothing to really do or say and clearly knowing nobody.

Then Mr. Fogel asked where we're from. Then others were talking to them.

As time was ticking, I went to say "HaMakom." Then Mr Fogel said he wanted us to know that our coming was meaningful and important to him and his wife. He said each person who comes - who shows they care - takes/shares some of their pain. For us who do not know them and did not know their wonderful son, daughter-in-law and grandchildren, to come just because - it is not a small thing.

We all knew at that moment - men, women and children - that it was so important that we came. Those few



words that connected total strangers to feel like one family - it was as if Hashem patted us all on the head and said "Yes, My children. Be together as one. It pleases Me greatly."

No one had to say a word or even look at each other. I know we all felt the same exact thing at that moment. We made our way to Udi's brothers who were sitting in different areas, sat for a bit and said HaMakom then got back on the bus to come home.

Someone told me that a local asked him why we came. Did we know Udi? No. The parents? No. Siblings? Someone from the community?? No. Then

WHY did we come? Because we had to. They felt it. We felt it. A bond that is so strong it goes beyond practical answers of why. It just is. Just because we have to.

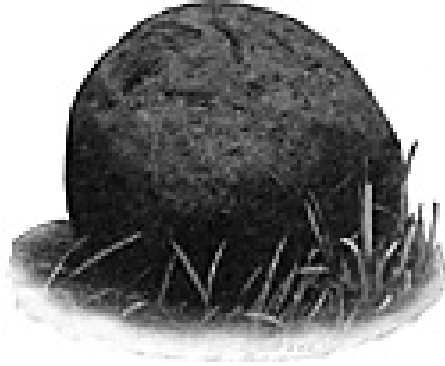
