■ A Sukkos Message From The Rav ■

Moraiy VeRabosaiy, and Ladies of BTYA:

As it turns out, I will not be at the Shul for the first day of Yom Tov, nor for שבת חול המועד.

I would normally have said that family considerations make it impossible, but I will apply habit # 1 of the Shabbos Shuvah derosha - due to family considerations, I have chosen to be in Yerushalayim. (Do you see how it is a completely different sentence?)

At this point, let me invite you to visit me in my newly redone (BH, and thank you Nechemya) huge sukkah in Yerushalayim, Rechov Michal 11 B (the B is the sukkah address). Please call first, though, 054-914-6311, to make sure I will be there.

I would ask the olom to keep two *yesodos* in mind, as we perform the 2 mitzvos of Sukkos: the סוכה and the 4 minim.

- Sukkah, at its most fundamental level, teaches how everything in this world is עראי (temporary and flimsy): wealth, possessions, physical health, emotional health, relationships...everything.

 HaShem, however, is the mainstay of all. The degree to which we maintain our מובה and וביטחון is the degree to which we are connected to something permanent and everlasting. We sit in the סוכת עראי and we remember "כי בסכות הושבתי את בני ", and we realize how that is an allencompassing truth for everything in our lives, whether we mamesh see it (ענני כבוד) or at least realize it (שנני נבוד).
- The 4 minim teach us to appreciate and to never stop thanking HaShem for what we do have. That is the idea of חג האסיף. It is a lack of gratitude to neglect doing so.

Be well, Yom Tov same ach, and a gutten Shabbos.



Torah, Torah and More Torah – Accomplishments and Opportunities

Baruch Hashem, the shul's beis medrash is bustling – from before dawn until after dusk. The doors open before vasikin and don't close until well after the late ma'ariv. And all the while, the sweet sound of torah learning can be heard.

BTYA members and many other RBS and Beit Shemesh residents are taking advantage of the comfortable and friendly beis medrash, as part of the diverse and exciting shiurim, learning b'chavrusa, or on their own.

What? You don't know what we're talking about?! Well, you just have to come and be a part of it, then. Even a little part, if that's all you can manage. But trust us, this is one of those OPPORTUNITIES that you cannot allow to just pass you by. You literally have so much to choose from, at so many times that ANYONE'S schedule could fit something in.

As we were saying, in addition to the eight (yes, eight!) morning shiurim (at all different levels), we have the zechus of hosting *two Kollelim*, an Israeli Kollel of **25** avreichim who learn in our beis medrash for morning and afternoon seder, as well as BTYA's own Kollel with **16** learners (half of whom take no stipend and simply love the learning!) whose kol torah reverberates all morning long. We're talking about **100** (!) people learning in our beis medrash on a daily basis. Every voice counts and adds more and more, so we are hoping to bring even more people to come learn with us and for them to see what we have to offer and what they've been missing. Most people that try it, like it, stay, and are so thankful they did.

As we are commanded "v'higisa bo yomam v'laila," and as mornings don't work for everyone, our beis medrash stays vibrant and alive into the night as well. When the workday ends and "free" time begins as the sky gets dark, there is plenty of the torah's light shining forth in our beis medrash with ten (did we say TEN?! Yes, we did -**Ten!)** shiurim for the taking. Covering a broad spectrum of inyanim (halacha, hashkafa, gemora...) and in different amounts of time (from a few minutes to over an hour) we have set up night seder so that there is SOMETHING that should fit into everyone's (yes, even YOURS!) schedule and learning taste. The 70+ people learning (and lighting) up the night include around 20 children - young and old, learning and living the torah in Eretz Yisrael! What an experience and zechus! And we'd love for even more to come and be a part of it all, as we still have so much to offer and to accomplish.

Be proud of your beis medrash. It has come a long way. And also be proud of your shul. The incredible makom torah our shul has become is just one (albeit a major one) aspect of what our shul is about, what the shul provides to members and the RBS community and what the shul seeks to accomplish going forward. It also shows how we are, BH and BEH, meriting great siyatta dishmayya in our efforts, הודו לה' כי טוב, כי לעולם

So, please help your beis medrash (and your shul) keep going and growing by visiting – morning, afternoon, or night, any time and all the time. It's the truest simchas torah you'll ever find.
