The following list contains recommended sources for preparing properly for the סיפור יציאת מצרים of מצוה

1. **מטעמי השולחן - סיפור יציאת מצרים**: has realistic descriptions of the שעבוד and the מכות; explains the מדה כנגד מדה and their other accomplishments and purposes; suggests how to visualize and make the סדר experience real; and discusses the basic principles taught through יציאת מצרים.
2. **400 מי יודע - 400** goes through the Haggada framing basic questions and citing basic answers. Mostly non-pshetlach, but rather basic ideas that one can elaborate on and expand upon.
3. **הגדה של פסח-אלישמע ואפרים יוצאים ממצרים** is for children, and is an excellent work.
4. **You Left Mitzrayim**, in English, by Simcha Grofman (KinderTorah).
5. **The Little Midrash Says Haggada** is good. For all ages, really.
6. **בית השם-הזכיה הגדולה** for kids of all ages, including adults, has a very vivid description of being oleh regel and bringing the korban Pesach. Has quite a bit of halachos, too. It's available in English as well, entitled "Three Special Days."
7. **גבורת ה' (מהר"ל)** a new printing in a 2-volume set, with (very) basic summaries in the margins. The parts that explain the Haggada have the text there, too. Volume 2 starts with the Haggada explanation.
8. **הגדת גדולי תנועת המוסר** in Hebrew - it's "heavy." Artscroll has a shortened, English version entitled, Haggada with Commentary Culled from the Classic Ba'alei Mussar.
9. **ליל שימורים** by HoRav Brevda, זצ"ל, with a section directly on the Haggada.
10. **The Haggada With Answers** by Artscroll, is done well and can trigger discussion and understanding.
11. **ספר החינוך מצוה כ"א** and the **רמב"ן** at the end of פרשת בא - basic fundamental concepts about yetzi'as mitzrayim
12. **Dual Discovery**: by Zecharya Hoffman - CIS Book - a fictional account of a Jew in Egypt who grew up thinking he was an Egyptian and discovering the truthtakes you through the slavery, makkos, and yetzi'as mitzrayim.....This book is appropriate for ages 12 and up.....done well....realistic.
13. **TarYag Mitzvohs HaShalem (Taryag Mitzvohs Project) Volume One**...Mitzvohs 1-24 - This volume is excellent and timely, as it has virtually all the mitzvohs of Pesach ...learning material for before, during, and after Pesach...gives a complete grasp of each Mitzvah, from dinim and Halachah, to philosophy and a deeper appreciation and understanding.
14. A children to age 15 - (adults may find it interesting) **-מרתף אוצרות העבר מאת מ. ספרא** - The story of shibud and yetzi'as mitzrayim, presented in the form of a found diary. IN HEBREW
15. **NEW FOR 5773**—This week's (March 15th) **The English Update** contains a fantastic description of the Korban Pesach, that originally appeared in the HaModia.

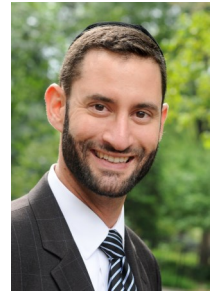

Siyum

This is the 57th consecutive year the family is sponsoring a siyum, and now for the first time in Israel.

Yeshivas Pirchei Shoshanim, Issur V'Hetter Smicha Program, with Rabbi Don Channen.

If you are considering this program, but couldn't join the introductory meeting, here are some of the main points:

- We are starting a chaburah, beginning the Sunday after Pesach (April 7), learning 2 lessons per week, with a chavrusah (or by yourself); we can provide the chavrusah, or you can bring your own. The chaburah will be officially learning at BTYA.
- 3 nights per week of very guided preparation, with access to the maggid shiur (Rabbi Channen - a tremendous expert and a very warm and approachable person) as a shoel u'meishiv, and 2 nights per week of an amazing live shiur.
- Capability level is variable (beginners will spend more time with the provided English sheets; more advanced learners will spend more time learning the actual seforim mentioned in the sheets).
- 100 NIS per month, with subsidies available (don't let financial issues stop you - we'll work it out, no matter what).
- In just over a year, they could be calling you "Rabbi".
- Sun-Thurs, 8:30-10:00 PM. (Time and location of preparation is somewhat flexible.)
- Show up on April 7, 8:30 PM, and try it out!
