**Boys Mishnayos Shiur**

The boys mishnayos shiur, led by R' Mordechai Bernstein, is now 1/3 of the way through סדר טהרות. On Sunday night, the shiur is starting נגעים. It's a great time to join in!

The boys learn approximately 5 mishnayos a night. That's 25 mishnayos a week...about 100 mishnayos a month!

Shiur is open to 5th graders and up; however, exceptions are made for very motivated kids who can keep the pace.

Here are some changes being made to the shiur format:

- Snacks every night.
- Every second Thursday there is an optional test. The highest mark gets a cash prize.
- Everyone who just takes the test will get a bonus treat such as Pizza or chulent. And don't worry about grades..., grading is optional. The idea is to encourage everyone to learn more, to study, for the test.
- There is a trip to ירושלים upon completion of a portion of the Seder. Seeing as the shiur just finished 1/3 of סדר טהרות, it's time for a trip!
- And, of course, a gala siyum on the completion of each seder.

Shiur starts now after the 8:00 PM מעריב. The shiur will start earlier when מעריב gets later, right after שבועות.

The goal is to finish סדר טהרות a few weeks after Chanuka.

It's a perfect time to join a great chabura and get a great understanding of the harder half of Shas Mishnayos (קדשים, טהרות וזרעים). The whole set takes a little less than 3 years to complete.

If you live a bit further away and would like to send your son, there is an option for "return" transporation.

Night Learning Program

Rabbi Joel Padowitz

Rabbi Padowitz will be giving a brief introduction & orientation to this program, **this Sunday night at 9:15 PM**. If you are interested in the program, come to understand what it’s all about.

A few words from Rabbi Padowitz:

I know you’ve seen the emails and flyers, but I wanted to make sure you understood what is so truly exciting about the new lilmod v’laasos program starting at BTYA next week.

You are probably familiar with Rav Yitzhak Berkovits, one of Israel’s leading English-speaking poskim and the Rosh Kollel of the Jerusalem Kollel—arguably the premier institution today for producing outreach rabbonim. Over the past two decades, Rav Berkovits has developed a method to enable both intermediate and advanced students to clearly understand sugyas in bite-sized chunks from their earliest sources down to halacha l’maaseh. Hundreds—if not thousands—have successfully used the technique to master large swaths of halacha and hashkafa in an enjoyable, efficient, memorable way.

The primary tool of Rav Berkovits’ method is his “Sheets.” Each Sheet is, first and foremost, a concise list of 7-15 essential sources from the p’sukim to the poskim. The citations are carefully sequenced so that each logically strings together, building on that which came before it to ensure the learner understands the underlying principles, the halachically-relevant shittos in the Rishonim, and the l’maaseh of each topic.

But the Sheets are much more than merely a list of mareh mekomos. After each citation on the list, Rav Berkovits has crafted a synopsis of that source. His summary not only ensures the learner properly understood the source, but also enables one who lacks the time or ability to comprehend a given source inside to still understand its main points. The sheets also provide photocopied excerpts of any texts which may be of limited supply in the beis midrash to ensure you have ready access to all the sources. The net effect is that the Sheets will enable you to understand a complex sugya from beginning to end, quickly and clearly.

I have been zoche to be a talmid of Rav Berkovits since 1994 and was one of the seven original avreichem who founded his Jerusalem Kollel in 2002—where I learned for 4 years before taking a rabbinic position in London. I have received permission to use his Sheets for our program, and hope to share whatever I have gained from Rav Berkovitz with the program’s participants.

The new lilmod v’laasos program starting at BTYA next week will begin with a study of the all-important “Six Constant Mitzvos.” Later this summer we will move on to highly relevant Bein Adam l’Chavero topics. We will use one set of Sheets each week to provide us with a clear structure, direction, and a pace. I am sure you will find that the Sheets with their embedded synopses provide a sufficiently flexible framework to be of an appropriate length whether you learn one or five nights a week with your chevrusa (And we still, of course, will get you a talented chevrusa if you are looking for one.) I will be available in the beis midrash as a sho’el u’mashiv for those who need and will offer an weekly shiur for all who are interested.

I look forward to seeing you there and answering any questions you might have about the program.
