

## YOMIM NORAIM SEATING & MEMBERSHIP SIGN-UP

Sign-up sessions for Yomim Noraim seats and Shul Membership will be held at the following times in the shul's office (off the shul's main lobby):

- Thursday, August 15: 9:00 – 10:15 PM
- Friday, August 16: 10:00 – 11:00 AM
- Sunday, September 18: 9:00 – 10:15 PM

These are the ONLY times for signing up, so please be sure to come at one of these times.

You can pay for seats and membership in the following ways:

- Hora'at keva – the preferred method – Israeli receipt (installments)
- Credit card - Israeli – Israeli receipt (installments)
- Credit card - US – Israeli receipt (installments) or US receipt (full payment only)
- Shekel or US Dollar (full payment or post-dated checks)
- Cash - Shekel or US Dollar (full payment only)

If you plan to pay by Hora'at Keva, PLEASE BRING A CHECK WITH YOU. WE NEED INFORMATION from the check to be able to fill out the form.

Payment must be made at the time of sign-up in order to reserve your seats.



## MEMBERSHIP AND SEAT RATES

If you are already paying via a *horaat keva* or have a valid credit card on file at the office, you can email the membership renewal form. You should have received information via email.

Membership and seat rates remain the same as last year, as follows:

### Membership

**Regular** (includes two seats for Yomim Nora'im): 235 ₪/ month

**Wife only** (includes one women's seat for Yomim Nora'im) 100 ₪/month (for wives whose husbands do not daven at the shul regularly)

### Seats

Members' children seats (including adult children)  
Rosh Hashana **and** Yom Kippur: 150 ₪  
Rosh Hashana **or** Yom Kippur: 100 ₪

Guests and non-members (including children)  
Rosh Hashana **and** Yom Kippur: 300 ₪  
Rosh Hashana **or** Yom Kippur: 200 ₪




