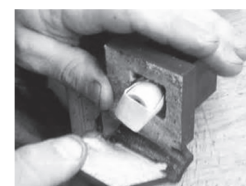
The Molad will be on Wednesday night at 10:41pm.

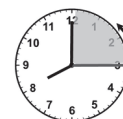
