There are only a few weeks left until the board is finalized, so seize the opportunity now!

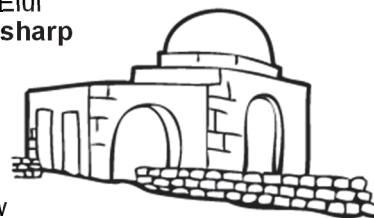
