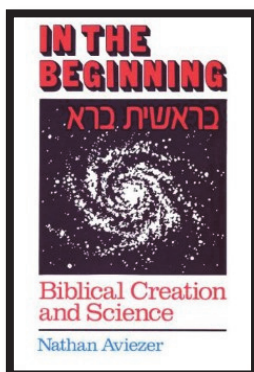

Professor Aviezer is a Professor of Physics and former Chairman of the Physics Department of Bar-Ilan University. Aviezer is the author of more than 140 scientific articles on solid-state physics. In recognition of his important research contributions, he was honored by being elected as a Fellow of the American Physical Society and a Research Professor of the Royal Society of London.

In addition to his scientific research, Aviezer has a long-standing interest in the relationship between Torah and science. He is the author of two books: *In the Beginning* (translated into nine languages) and *Fossils and Faith* (translated into four languages). Aviezer teaches a course at Bar-Ilan University on "Torah and Science," which was awarded the prestigious Templeton Prize.
