The BTYA Vasikin Minyon will meet each day of Sukkos in the main Beis Medrash at about 6:40 in the morning. (Note that on Shabbos Chol Hamoed we will meet in the Vasikin room and on Simchas Torah there will not be a Vasikin Minyon at BTYA. IY"H we will have a **Kiddush** in the BTYA Sukkah on both Sukkos and Shabbos Chol Hamoed.)

Going on a tiyul on Sukkos? The BTYA minyon is the best way to start your day and get on the road at the earliest possible time (you'll also benefit from davening at the optimum time in the morning).

Join us this Shabbos for a Kiddush sponsored by **Tzvi Goldman**. Shacharis begins at 6:05 and the famous Weisman Cholent will be at about 8:00am.

A NOTE FROM THE RAV on PUBLIC SUKKAS:

The Rav recommends bringing food which does not ordinarily demand a Succah...He hopes that this is an unnecessary precaution, but public Succas are notoriously unreliable. Also, the Mishna Berura cites a chumrah that *mamesh* a regular meal, just without bread or mezonos, might require a Succah (though no beracha should be said).
