



The Kedars invite the kehillah to a Kiddush after davening (men in the Beis Medrash and Women in the Ezras Nashim).



Although one person at a time saying *kaddish* is the preferred way, it is felt to be unworkable in a minyan which has a public flow of different people. Hence, *kaddish* is said together by many people; hence many *kaddeishim* are skipped, since it is wrong to just say "extra" *kaddeishim*.



All of these *kaddeishim* are printed in the siddur for the shul lucky enough to have one person at a time say *kaddish* (as is the case in the shul's vasikin minyan!)

Rav Malinowitz, shlit'a and Rav Channen, shlit'a will be giving Smicha to those who complete the program.




Chevra Chaburah

Shabbos Hachanah



Moraiy veRabosaiy and Women of BTYA:

I am sure that you all remember that in the past , we have arranged for a “Shabbos Tefillah”, a Shabbos as close as possible to Rosh haShanah, where the theme of Tefillah was explored in depth, different aspects discussed, and strategies for *kavanah* examined.

This year we will doing things somewhat, but not completely differently. On Shabbos Nitzavim, next Shabbos, 2 days before Rosh haShanah, we will be inaugurating a “Shabbos **Hachanah**”, A Shabbos of Preparation, with its theme being how to prepare for the upcoming Rosh haShanah in a down-to-earth, feasible, meaningful manner.

In the pattern of “Shabbos Tefillah”, there will be a

- 10-15 minute “introduction” after Kabbalas Shabbos (there will not be an “early minyan” starting next week)
- Shabbos *derashah* focused on preparation game-plans
- Hour-long “shiur” starting at 5pm (for men and women) “mapping out” the 48 hours of Rosh haShanah (AUB wil be at 4:00pm, instead of at 5:00pm).

Also, Ari Stern will be giving the chaburah that Shabbos, *b'inanei Tefillah*.

And we are discussing having *seudah shlishis* (for men) together.

Undoubtedly, IYH, this *hachanah* will be the catalyst for a *tzibba* וחתימה טובה
