Yomim Noraim Seating & Membership Sign-Up



If you have a valid hora'at keva (bank or credit card) with the shul, you can sign up for Yomim Noraim seats and shul membership either **by email** (preferable) or in person (in the shul office). If you do not have a hora'at keva with the shul, you'll need to sign up in person, or call in a credit number and then sign up by email.

SIGN-UP BY E-MAIL

You can pay for seats and membership in the following ways:

- **Bank hora'at keva or Israeli credit card** (that is already on file with the shul) – Israeli tax receipts.
- **US Credit card** (that is already on file with the shul) – US or Israeli tax receipts – let us know whether you want to pay in dollars (US receipt) or shekels (Israeli receipt).
- **US Bank Transfer.** Please visit www.btya.org/USDpay. Using a Bank Transfer "costs" BTYA significantly less than using a US Credit Card.
- **The Credit Card Machine in the Shul.** There is a new category under BTYA for Shul Membership 5779.

All payments are in 12 monthly installments unless otherwise requested (first payment for membership only, remaining 11 for payments membership combined with total cost of seats).

To sign up by e-mail, see the email already sent to you via the shul office. If you need another copy write to membership@btya.org.

To sign up in person: Sign-up sessions will be held Sunday – Thursday mornings between 8:15a.m. and 10:30 a.m. in the shul office (off the shul main lobby).

If you sign up in person, you can pay for seats and membership in the following ways:

- **Bank hora'at keva** – Israeli tax receipt (installments)
- **Credit card - Israeli** – Israeli tax receipt (installments)
- **Credit card - US** – installments - US or Israeli tax receipts – **PLEASE** let us know whether you want to pay in dollars (US receipt) or shekels (Israeli receipt)
- **Check – Shekel or US Dollar** (post-dated checks)
- **Cash – Shekel or US Dollar** (full payment only)

If you plan to pay by Bank hora'at Keva, PLEASE BRING AN ISRAELI CHECK WITH YOU. WE NEED INFORMATION from the check to be able to fill out the form.
