



## The Chaburah ,The Kehillah, and Our Smachos (aka ,Simchos)

As we close on the 3rd successful year of the Shabbos morning Chaburah, I would like to first thank my Chaburah Partners, Naftali Rischall (may Hashem comfort him) and David Blass for their active partnership in establishing and perpetuating the program.

Many benefits ensued from the Chaburah—not least, the Kehillah enjoyed the Torah talents (some of them previously unknown) of so many of our members and friends. In addition, the concept of the Chaburah was designed not so much for the *Limud Torah* itself, but to get together after davening as a Kehillah and to increase the "chevra" aspect of the Shul. Whereas we used to leave Shul and go our separate ways right after Shabbos morning *Tfillah*, now we assemble together have a little kiddush and spend quality time with each other. The feedback I received regarding this program has been very positive. Another outcome of the Chaburah has been the emergence of an ad-hoc men's kiddush committee to help *baalei simcha* more fully enjoy their *simcha* and reduce the expenses of a larger kiddush that using the hall entails.

As we go into Shana Dalet of the Chaburah, though, we want to address a phenomenon that has recently developed—*davka* as a result of the Chaburah's success! In the past, people traditionally celebrated their simcha with a kiddush, which is indeed a universal gesture. Although kiddushim varied in their size and expense, they

All eating stops. No seudah hamafsekes as on an ordinary erev Tish'a B'Av.	<b>7:30</b>	תחילת הצום

"Baruch hamavdil bein kodesh l'chol" must be said (there is no havdalah), and cannot be said before **8:12 pm**. One should not daven Maariv and say Kinnos in Shabbos clothing. One cannot bring things to Shul on Shabbos until after saying "Baruch Hamavdil..." .

## Fast of Tisha B'Av Notes

- Regular seudah shlishis. Stop eating by 7:30pm. All issurim start then.
- One may bentch after sunset, saying "retzei."
- One should not display obvious signs of mourning even *bein hashemashos*-removing shoes, sitting on the floor, changing into weekday clothing.
- At the time of *motza'ei Shabbos* (the Shul's official time is 8:12 pm), say "Baruch hamavdil bein kodesh l'chol," remove shoes and Shabbos clothing, and stop sitting on chairs until *chatzos* the next day.
- "Borei me'orei ha'ais" on a candle will be said in Shul for everyone at 8:50pm, immediately followed by Maariv. You may say this brocho at home after saying "baruch hamavdil..." Women can say it if there is no man to be *motzi* them.
- "Attah chonantanu" is said in Ma'ariv.
- Whoever is **not** fasting must remember to make havdala first, whenever that may be. Even a woman. Only "borei p'ri hagofen" and the long final brocho "baruch...hamavdil bein...baruch atta...bein kodeh l'chol." It should be over grape juice. After the fast, it may be said over wine.
- Water may be drunk before havdala.
- A child need not make havdala before eating.

were all golden opportunities for the Kehilla to bond together and appropriately mark a life event of one of its members—extended Mishpacha, if you will. A member's simcha is an important event for the whole Kehilla and the associated kiddush should be a central social event for the Shul.

Recently, a number of simchas have been celebrated via the chaburah – with an enhanced menu - as an alternative to making a regular kiddush. This arrangement has had the benefit of adding a Torah dimension to the Kiddush, and certainly has reduced the cost of the kiddushim, both very important considerations. But without question, the social dimension of the kiddush has been greatly diminished, something that we feel is a serious loss for the social fabric of the Kehilla.

After discussion with the Rav, we are returning to the traditional format, namely that a simcha such as a Bar Mitzvah or an Aufruf should be celebrated with a kiddush, not through "sponsoring a Chaburah". The kiddush can certainly still be made in the Shul//Ezras Nashim, with the attendant reduced cost, of course a kiddush in the ulam is very welcome as well. Kiddushim need to include both men and women, in order to enhance the social benefits for the entire Kehilla. In the event of a Kiddush in the shul, the Kiddush committee headed by Mrs. Shari Gherman and Mrs. Michelle Frankel –can be contacted to help the baalei simcha plan and set up the men's and women's kiddush in the bais medrash and the ezras nashim respectively.

In this format, it is recommended that the baal simcha speaks; certainly the Rav or another Shul representative may also say a few words. But there will no longer be a Chaburah the Shabbos of a member's simcha. Please contact me, David Kallus to help you with organizing your simcha and thinking through which option meets your family's needs most optimally.

May we share in many smachos/simchas as a Kehilla.
