

Israel returns to Standard Time on Motza'ei Shabbos at 2:00AM. Remember to set your clocks back one hour before going to sleep!

Davening times at BTYA will generally remain unchanged, except for the obvious:

Vasikin still starts 25 minutes before sunrise, but your clock will now read an hour earlier.

- Tefillas Mincha Ketanah will start at 4:35pm this week. On Sunday and Monday, Mincha will be located in the main Beis Medrash. On Tuesday, it will move upstairs to the Vasikin Room, and remain there all winter.
- Shabbos start and end times next week will all be an hour earlier.
