From the Desk of the President

To the Dear Kehillah Hakedosha Beis Tefillah Yonah Avraham,

One year in Elul, the Saba M'Slobodka gave a sicha to his yeshivah. In the sicha he expounded that the way for a person to succeed in the Days of Judgement was to be *Maavir Al Midossav*. He finished his sicha and the Yeshivah davened Maariv. After Maariv the Saba requested to speak again. He said that which I said earlier, that *Maavir Al Midossav* is a *segulah* is indeed true, but since it's still too difficult we need a short term "secret weapon". The quickest route to success in succeeding at this *din* is to benefit the *tzibbur* and be *mezakai harabim*.

The source that being *Maavir Al Midossav* can work to bring us quick forgiveness is the Gemarah in Rosh Hashana 17a:

Rava said: "Anyone who is *Maavir Al Middosav*, they forgo his sins,...For whom is He a forgiver of iniquity? For one who is a forgoer of transgression."

Rashi explains that a *Maavir Al Midossav* is one who does not give out judgment to those who mistreat him but overcomes his normal behavior... so in response

Midah Hadin passes over him the same way *midah kneged midah*. In our story, at first, the Saba M'Slobodka thought this power was the only chance we have to succeed during the *Yimei Hadin*. But what exactly is the reason that *Maavir Al Midossav* works? What is the mechanism?

Rav Dessler (ME 5, page 70) explains that one who is ***Maavir Al Midossav* negates his own sense of self for the good of those around him, and thus enables himself to blend with the people around him.** For this reason, one who does so is not judged by strict judgment; rather, one is judged as part of the community and it is much easier to get a lenient judgment when you are one in a million.

If this is true then the Saba both before and after his retraction was in essence saying the same thing! He was really saying that there is only one way to be successful in the *Yimei Hadin* - through the *tzibbur*! Whether it's through giving up on your personal motives or actually being *mezakah* the rabim by working for them, the *tzibbur* is the vehicle that you need during this period of judgment.

Interestingly, another version of this same story about the Saba M'slabodka describes him saying in a shiur that the only way to be *zocheh* in the *din* is to be *Maavir Al Midossav* and a week later he said, no that's too hard, the only way to be *zoche* in the *din* is **to see the *tzibbur* with a good eye an "ayin tova"**. Its inescapable! the only way to win is to connect to the *tzibbur* whether it is by being *mevater* to each other, looking at each other with a good eye or helping each other. Our great defense attorney for the *yimei hadin* is telling his clients there is only one way to get off the hook!

I am turning to you the *kehilla* to take these words to heart. First and foremost I request *mechila* of you both on my behalf and on behalf of all those who work to make BTYA a better place. *Mechila* for anything that I/we may have done that was disturbing, offensive or hurtful to anyone, and *mechila* for anything that I/we should have done as part of our commitment to BTYA that I/we failed to do. This has been a very difficult year for the *tzibbur*. For the past half year things have not been the same without the Rav at our helm the way we have grown accustomed to always benefit from him for so many years, and the *tzibbur* continues to fervently daven for the Rav's *refuah shelayma*. To this end, I beseech you all, men and women, to look at each other with an *ayin tova* and be *mochel* each other so that we can merit a more beneficial outcome for our *tzibbur* in 5780.

Before concluding, I would like to again publicly personally thank Rav Jacobson for graciously agreeing - literally at the last minute and during the busiest time of the year - to serve as our Interim Rav. Rav Jacobson's unique blend of talents together with his commitment and dedication are already making an impact during the very first weeks in this new role. May HKBH Bless all of his efforts and give him and his family all of the rewards promised to those who serve the *tzibbur* faithfully.

I would like to conclude with a request, one that you will be hearing more about during the coming weeks. I would ask each of you - men, women and families - to begin to think of additional ways that you can contribute to the *tzibbur*. **Think about how you can join me and others in working to be *mezakah* the *tzibbur*. As explained earlier, this is a great way to succeed in the *din* as well as benefit us all.** There are so many needs at BTYA, and there is likewise so much talent; the opportunities for *chesed* abound. You will be hearing more about this in the coming weeks, please begin to consider ways in which you can chip in more and thus strengthen your bond with the *tzibbur*.
